Chafee is a program through the Department of Social Services which provides youth between the ages of 14 and 21 services to assist them in transitioning into adulthood. Referrals are completed by Children's Division workers. Services provided include, but are not limited to, registration for camps, transitional living services, secondary educational services, and aftercare services.

A kids closet is available to provide clothing, diapers, hygiene items, etc. A prom closet is available to youth in need of formal attire.
